NEET 2026 cancelled...

One of the key accused identified by investigators is Jaipur-based Manish, believed to be a central link in the network. Another suspect, Rakesh Mandawaria, who runs a consultancy in Sikar, is also under interrogation. The probe intensified after Nashik Crime Branch arrested 30-year-old Shubham Khairnar, a final-year BAMS student from Nandgaon, who allegedly shaved his head and altered his appearance to evade arrest.

1.20L aspirants from...

Vice Chancellor of Medical University Jabalpur Dr Ashok Khandelwal said, "Paper leak incidents are very harsh for the students appearing in NEET. It is a tough stand of the Central government for a re-test for over 22 lakh students. Around 1.20 lakh students of Madhya Pradesh too will appear again. But it is a correct decision as it will check incompetent students from taking admission in MBBS courses."

MP HC judge cycles to...

What made the scene more striking was that his security personnel also accompanied him on bicycles instead of the usual official convoy.

India's oil giants stare...

However, despite crude largely trading below the \$115-per-barrel level so far, the actual loss trajectory has already exceeded those forecasts. The sharp rise in energy prices has also prompted concerns over domestic fuel security and supply stability.

Addressing these fears, Puri said India currently has enough crude oil reserves and LNG supplies for about 60 days, while LPG stocks are sufficient for around 45 days.

MP sizzles as Ratlam hits...

Meteorologists said weak western disturbances failed to bring pre-monsoon showers or relief to central India, allowing temperatures to remain unusually high across Madhya Pradesh. Hot and dry continental winds from western regions also pushed daytime temperatures beyond 42°C in many districts while suppressing humidity levels.

The Meteorological Department issued a heatwave alert for isolated places in Alirajpur, Jabua, Dhar, Indore, Ratlam and Ujjain for the next 24 hours.

HC reserves order in...

NGT orders probe...

NEET cancellation triggers outrage among aspirants across country

PTI NEW DELHI

The cancellation of NEET-UG 2026 has triggered nationwide outrage among aspirants, with students raising questions regarding competence of the National Testing Agency (NTA) and demanding that the medical entrance exam be conducted by AIIMS-Delhi.

The examination for students seeking admission to undergraduate courses in medical colleges will now be held afresh on dates to be notified separately.

The cancellation of the annual test has left aspirants grappling with frustration and anxiety.

For 17-year-old Nikhil Kumar from Delhi's Chirag Dilli, the NTA's decision meant losing what he believed would have been a good score.

"My expected score was around 540, which would have given me a good chance. Now, we will have to reappear for the

exam while trying to keep our preparation at its best," Kumar told PTI.

Another aspirant, Mounita Das from Kolkata, said the development was "simply disheartening" for both her and her parents.

"A lot of sacrifices go into preparing for an exam like NEET-UG. It takes years of discipline,

not just for me but also for my parents. It is quite difficult to get back into the mindset to keep preparing when everything feels like it is falling apart," Das added.

Lamenting the cancellation of exam, a student from Dehradun said the NEET preparation involves "so many sleepless nights".

TEJASHWI ALLEGES GOVERNANCE FAILURE

RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav on Tuesday attacked Prime Minister Narendra Modi over the cancellation of NEET-UG 2026, alleging that the exam was scrapped due to a paper leak and had jeopardised the future of 23 lakh students. He questioned the government's ability to conduct examinations transparently and criticised the "endless chain" of paper leaks in Bihar and across the country. Referring to a recent case in Nalanda, where police arrested three fake solvers, including an MBBS student, Tejashwi alleged that repeated irregularities reflected administrative failure and caused financial, physical and mental distress to students and their families.

Earlier, Bhagirath, 25, had lodged a complaint in Karimnagar II Town Police Station against the girl and her parents. He alleged that they attempted to honey trap him and demanded Rs.5 crore to not file a police complaint against him.
